

### You will need

- ♥ Pale yellow yarn
- ♥ Light green yarn
- ♥ 3 mm crochet hook
- ♥ Bendy drinking straw

### Creating the trumpet

Using the pale yellow yarn, create a Magic ring with 6 sts (Fig 1)

#### 1st round

2 dc into every dc (12 st) (Fig 2)

#### 2nd round

\*1 dc, 2 dc into next dc. \*6 times (18 st) (Fig 3)

#### 3rd – 5th round

\*1 dc into every dc (18 st) (Fig 4)

#### 6th round

\*1 dc into next 2 dc, 2 dc into next dc. \*6 times (24 st) (Fig 5)

#### 7th round

\*1 dc into next 3 dc. 2 dc into next dc. \*6 times (30 st) (Fig 6)

#### 8th round

\*1 dc into next 3 dc, 2 dc into next 2 dc. \*6 times (42 st) (Fig 7)

### Creating the petals

Using the pale yellow yarn, start by creating a 4 stitch chain

#### 1st row

Miss 1 ch, 2 dc into first dc, 1 dc next dc, 2 dc into last dc, 1 ch (6 st) (Fig 8)

#### 2nd row

Miss 1 dc, 1 dc into next 4 dc, 2 dc into next dc, 1 chain (7 st) (Fig 9)

#### 3rd row

Miss 1, 1 dc into next 5 dc, 2 dc into next dc, 1 chain (8 st) (Fig 10)

#### 4th row

Miss 1, 1 dc into next 6 dc, 2 dc into dc, 1 chain (9 st) (Fig 11)

#### 5th row

Miss 1, 1 dc into every dc (8 st) (Fig 12)

#### 6th row

Miss 1, 1 dc into every dc (7 st) (Fig 13)

#### 7th row

Miss 1, 1 dc into every dc (6 st) (Fig 14)

#### 8th row

Miss 1, 1 dc into every dc (5 st) (Fig 15)

#### 9th row

Miss 1, 1 dc into every dc (4 st) (Fig 16)

#### 10th row

Miss 1, 1 dc into every dc (3 st) (Fig 17)

#### 11th row

Miss 1, 1 dc into every dc (2 st) (Fig 18)

#### 12th row



# Spring Daffodils

This cheery spring flower designed by Ikkle Dragon is so quick and simple to make, you'll want to make a whole bunch!

Miss 1, 1 dc (1 st) (Fig 19)

Repeat the steps to create 5 more petals (Fig 20)

### Creating the stem

Using the light green yarn, create a Magic ring with 6 sts (Fig 21)

#### 1st round

2 dc into every dc (12 st) (Fig 22)

#### 2nd – 5th round

1 dc into every dc (12 st) (Fig 23)

#### 6th round

\*1 dc, skip 1 dc, 1 dc. \*4 times (8 st) (Fig 24)

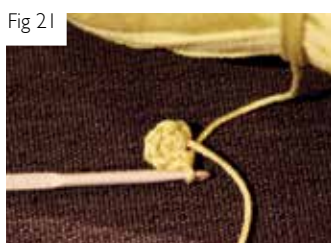
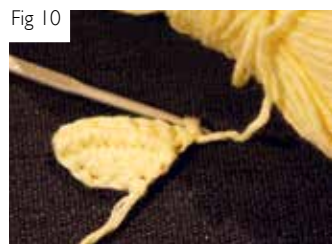
#### 7th round

1 dc into every dc (8 st) (Fig 25)  
Repeat 7th round until the stem is as long as the bendy drinking straw (Fig 26). Place the straw inside the

stem then sew up the bottom (Fig 27)

### Making up

Sew on the petals to the flat base of the trumpet. Sew the stem to the back of the trumpet (Fig 28). Your crocheted flowers are now ready to be displayed!



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
